THE TENNIS RETREAT

We view these trips as a retreat. Time spent away from the usual routine, a deliberately chosen opportunity for rest, reflection, and some focused time on our love of tennis. Below is a flavour for how the week is organised.

Step off the plane into warm Mediterranean sun. After arrival formalities a 45-minute drive through **Peloponnese** countryside dense with Kalamata olive groves and the **Ionian Sea** gradually comes into view. Soon you are in **Costa Navarino** sitting quietly in its stunning coastline on the Ionian Sea. Buildings of stone designed in the style of old Messinian mansions.

Check-in to the **five-star Westin Resort**, then take a wander for first sight of the beautiful surroundings to be home for the week. An early evening **Welcome Reception**, to unwind, meet fellow travellers, discuss and plan the week ahead. An easy-going group of individuals, friends, couples brought together by a common love of tennis and luxury travel. Not forgetting **non-playing** travel companions who are well looked after. There is something for everyone.

A **breakfast** of fresh local produce and diverse buffet of international cuisine in Morias restaurant. A short shuttle ride and you are at the **Mouratoglou Tennis Centre** for your first session. Admire the world-class clay courts and surroundings whilst you meet the coaches. Feel like a pro for two hours with **passionate**, skilled coaches on meticulously maintained courts. Improve in these daily sessions over the course of the programme designed specifically for us. With no more than four players per court per coach. If desired book optional additional coaching sessions, free play or challenge the

coach. Though two hours a day is more than enough to benefit. A late afternoon closing fun tournament run by the coaches to practice what you have learnt rounds off the tennis.

After tennis do as much or as little you wish. Wellness in the Anazoe Spa, water sports, visit local natural or historical sites, or just rest on the Dunes Beach or by the pool. Non tennis travel companions might play a round of golf. Barbouni perhaps for lunch on the Dunes Beach or the poolside restaurant.

Midweek meet for dinner, including drinks, with our group in Flame, or a similar resort restaurant. In a relaxed and easy-going atmosphere. Other evenings at complete leisure, maybe informally arrange dinner with some of the group, or simply take personal time.

Everything is organised and taken care of in person from start to finish. A programme designed to be carefree with none of the pressure from a rigid schedule.

Costa Navarino is a sustainably driven destination in the Mediterranean, located in the Greek region of Messinia in the southwest Peloponnese. One of the most unspoiled and breathtaking seaside landscapes, this is a region shaped by 4,500 years of history. The Costa Navarino philosophy is driven by a genuine desire to preserve the natural beauty and heritage of Messinia.

With a total of four luxury resorts, four signature golf courses, private residences, more than 40 dining and entertainment venues, and an abundance of sports and entertainment experiences across its sites, Costa Navarino has established Messinia as a place to visit as well as to live.

The dates currently on offer for 2025 are for 7 nights commencing 7 September 2025, 14 September 2025, 21 September 2025 and 28 September 2025. Other dates may be added according to demand and availability.

The timetable leaves plenty of personal time to be enjoyed as wished. However, if some or all on a particular trip would like to have dinner together on other nights, we will arrange those during the week. Similarly for excursions or other activities.

Welcome drinks reception in the Westin Lobby early evening on arrival day. An opportunity for everyone to meet, get to know each other and discuss the plan and arrangements for the week.

Tennis Programme 14 hours of tennis comprising 12 hours of group coaching and a 2-hour closing event such as an Ultimate Tennis Showdown tournament. Play is on the Mouratoglou Tennis Centre clay courts with a maximum ratio of one coach to four players. Subject to availability it will be possible to book additional coaching or court time. All coaches are proficient in English.

We can accommodate a range of skill levels each week, including beginners, and it will be helpful if at the time of booking you could give an indication of how long you have played tennis and your current level. There is something for everybody and you can expect to improve your play over the week.

Please note the need to, ideally, wear clay court shoes but minimum proper tennis shoes in order to protect the clay courts and against injury. Contact us if you have any questions on this.

A UNIQUE TENNIS EXPERIENCE



Enjoy a bespoke tennis programme designed by with the Mouratoglou team exclusively for us. One coach, no more than four players per court for 12 hours of coaching culminating in a 2-hour fun UTS style tournament to conclude the week. A range of skill levels can be accommodated, for example a week might include a coach and court dedicated to a beginners group, or an advanced group. The goal is for everyone to improve their play over the course of the week; there is something for everybody.


Whilst the quality of the facility matters, it is coaches who define the experience. Many apply to Mouratoglou tennis centres worldwide, but few are chosen. Ultimately, they are ambassadors of the brand, and as well as technical skills, must be fully aligned with its values and capable of purposefully following the Mouratoglou methodology, delivering consistent high quality client outcomes wherever the centre is in the world. In this spirit the coaching team for the Costa Navarino 2025 season includes coaches who can teach beginners to professional players needing performance level training.

Additional optional private coaching or play can be arranged before or whilst on location. We have a close relationship with the tennis centre leaving us well placed to organise or create special events on request. This might be a tournament for a club group, a more intense tennis programme, private individual coaching or with one of the performance coaches. It is a considerable advantage using local coaches who are experienced with clay and the conditions generally.

Together with the Costa Navarino Resort and wider Messinia it makes for an unrivalled experience.

Away from the sea the area is made up of the rolling Messinian countryside of dense olive groves which run up to the tennis centre. A peaceful and relaxing surrounding in which to pursue tennis.

The development of Costa Navarino saw the biggest olive tree-transplanting programme in Europe, with more than 7,000 olive trees replanted to date. Additionally, more than 9,900 new indigenous trees and 1,200,000 endemic shrubs of different species have been planted so far.





9. Dunes beach



10. Golf options

Whilst we are not knowledgeable about golf, we can say that Costa Navarino is now respected as a leading golf destination with four 18-hole signature golf courses. Booking in advance is highly recommended. Further details follow below, and we are happy to make and confirm all golf bookings. This is a brief overview of the golf courses available in Costa Navarino:

THE DUNES COURSE

Designed by two-time US Masters Champion Bernhard Langer in association with European Golf Design, The Dunes Course is Greece's first signature golf course. Set in diverse natural scenery with spectacular sea and river views, it takes its name from the tall dunes that separate several holes from a golden beach.

THE BAY COURSE

The Bay Course, designed by the legendary Robert Trent Jones Jr., offers panoramic sea and mountain views, with two holes playing along the historic Bay of Navarino. The course meanders through three contrasting natural landscapes that make for a dramatic and memorable round.

INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIC ACADEMY COURSE

The International Olympic Academy Golf course designed by the two-time Masters champion and Ryder Cup legend José María Olazábal, set above the coastline and offer panoramic views of the surrounding countryside, the Bay of Navarino and the Ionian Sea.

THE HILLS COURSE

The Hills course designed by the two-time Masters champion and Ryder Cup legend José María Olazábal overlooks the rural landscape of Messinia with rugged mountains and small villages.

OLIVE OIL TASTING: Join a tutored olive oil tasting session in which you will learn by local experts how to discern the subtle flavours of the region's renowned extra virgin olive oil. Tasting sessions are held at Enoteca.

OLIVE HARVESTING: Experience first-hand one of Messinia's most enduring culinary traditions, as you participate in olives' seasonal journey from tree to table, from harvesting the age-old way to olives' pressing at a nearby mill, until you taste the region's renowned extra virgin olive oil that has been produced right before your eyes.

WINE MASTERCLASS: Expand your oenological knowledge at our Wine Masterclasses. Learn about Greek and local wines from the experts and assess the characteristics of certain Messinian Varieties. Tasting sessions are held at Enoteca, accompanied by savoury snacks.

FISHING & BIRDWATCHING: Visit Gialova lagoon, one of the most iconic spots in the region, and discover the art of shore fishing with the help of local fishermen or get up-close to more than 217 bird species that grace the lagoon in a guided birdwatching experience.

EMBROIDERY WORKSHOP: Discover this ancient craft, and the relaxation it brings, in a 90-min beginner-friendly class. Learn about the local styles and techniques handed down over centuries, master the basics, and create a piece of traditional embroidery.

MOSAIC WORKSHOP: Learn how to make classic and contemporary mosaics using local stone and marble. Familiarize your hands with mosaic tools, materials and techniques to create your own piece of art.

ASTRONOMY NIGHTS: Organized by the Navarino Environmental Observatory and Navarino Natura Hall, each Astronomy Night begins when the stars come out and usually lasts for hours, when planets glow brightly in the sky and starlight illuminates the night.

PHILOSOPHY WALKS: Follow in the footsteps of the ancient Greek thinkers on a "Philosophy Walk" against the idyllic backdrop of the Messinian countryside. Led by classical scholars, these walks offer a unique opportunity to discuss important modern-day issues through the prism of ancient Greek philosophical thinking and find answers to contemporary problems by drawing on the wisdom of the past.

ART TOUR: Art is a fundamental aspect of the Costa Navarino experience, with original works by Greek and international artists forming an integral part of the interior design in Navarino Dunes. A 90-minute guided tour of the art collections gives guests the opportunity to gain an appreciation of artworks and artifacts of the 17th-19th centuries.

BOTANICAL TOUR: Enjoy a fascinating morning learning about local herbs and their unique benefits for the human body. The tour takes place in our botanical gardens.

13. The Region of Messinia

FLORA

Messinia harbours a colourful mosaic of rich and diverse flora, including Greek Firs and Black Pine trees in the woodlands of Mount Taygetos, Aleppo Pine trees in the coastal forests around the Nedas estuary, as well as Mediterranean maquis, irises, orchids, Juniper trees and Posidonia sea grass.

FAUNA

Thanks to its unique geographic location, Messinia is one of the first places in continental Greece (and mainland Europe in general) where migratory birds stopover in the spring. There are some sparsely inhabited places, which host significant populations of songbirds, raptors and sea fowl. The Mount Taygetos ridge is a haven for a variety of bird species. The upland forests and alpine areas, as well as the gorges on the lower parts close to Messinian Mani, are among the richest habitats for raptors and forest species (such as woodpeckers). The outstanding natural heritage of Messinia includes also the second most important Mediterranean habitat of the Caretta caretta sea turtle in the Gulf of Kyparissia, the Mediterranean seal and the Bottlenose dolphin around the Inousses islets near Methoni.

GIALOVA LAGOON

A key stopover in the flyway of migratory birds, Gialova lagoon, Greece's southernmost major wetland, has been declared an Important Bird

Area (IBA), providing shelter to 271 of the 442 recorded bird species in Greece and supporting a mosaic of habitats. It is the only refuge in Europe of the African chameleon, a unique species of reptile that changes skin color depending on its mood and surroundings. This magnificent lagoon, surrounded by the natural bay of Voidokilia and featuring a significant sand-dune ecosystem is also an archaeological site, making it one of the best-known ecotourism destinations in Messinia.

HABITATS

Important habitats for conservation are present in many areas of Messinia: the coniferous forests of Greek Fir and Black Pine trees on Mount Taygetos, the Mediterranean Strawberry tree forest on Sapientza Island, the sand-dune ecosystem in the Gulf of Kyparissia, the caves in the Nedas gorge, and Gialova lagoon, the biggest wetland of Messinia.

VILLAGES OF MESSINIA

Messinia is dotted with quaint villages of traditional stone houses, steeped in history and lore where Greek hospitality, unaltered through the centuries, is wholeheartedly offered all year round, especially by local establishments such as welcoming cafes and old-time tavernas.



14. Historical sites

With a fascinating history that goes back 4,500 years, Messinia's cultural past reveals a rich tapestry of kings and queens, honor and tradition, war and friendship. The Romanos Resort provides the ideal base from which to explore this checkered past.
